SUB: REVISION OF STORAGE CHARGES FOR CARGO AT SUTARKANDL

The competent Authority has approved the revision of charges for storage of cargo at the Sutarkandi Land Ports as per the rates indicated below: -

Note:

1. Packed or bagged material to be stored in covered space and Loose cargo to be stored in open space.

2.Per MT or per CBM- whichever is higher will be charged.

3. Stocking height- Minimum of (3 stacks or 2 meters height).

4. When the cumulative storage charge of items stored at warehouse exceeds 70% of the declared value of the goods, LPAI will have right to auction the item to recover the Storage Charge.
